Re: Allen & Auglaize Counties Congressional Art Contest

Thank you for your interest in the 2009 Congressional Art Contest! Each high school may submit one two-dimensional piece of artwork to compete in the county wide contest. The school winner must live in the Fourth Congressional District: Champaign, Shelby, Auglaize, Logan, Hardin, Allen, Hancock, Morrow, Marion, Richland and the western half of Wyandot counties. The winning art piece must meet the 2009 Art Competition Guidelines available at Congressman Jordan's website.

Only the district winner must be framed before it is displayed in the U.S. Capitol. Entries are not required to be framed prior to judging.

The organizer for Allen/Auglaize/Hardin Counties is Vanessa Damschroder, Education Director of ArtSpace/Lima. ArtSpace/Lima will facilitate the judging of the work selected. The chosen piece must arrive at ArtSpace/Lima by Saturday, April 18th. If the piece is being delivered in person, the hours of operation are 10am-5pm Tuesday-Friday and from 10am-2pm Saturday. Please allow 5 business days if you choose to mail your work in. The judging of the work will take place after Tuesday April 21st.

After April 28th, work may be picked up at ArtSpace/Lima during normal business hours (Tuesday-Friday, 10am-5pm, Saturday, 10am-2pm) or include a SASE with your mailed work and we will return it to you the first week of May. The SASE must be enclosed to ensure prompt return of the piece.
